

SHOOTOUT UNDER THE MIDNIGHT SUN

FAQ:

Q: **Can I fill out the application on my computer?**

A: Yes. In fact the registration staff would appreciate it, although it can be printed and filled out manually.

Q: **Do you take credit cards?**

A: No. Cash, check or money orders only at the time.

Q: **Does each "shooter" and "conventioneer" have to fill out an application?**

A: Yes. This may seem inconvenient for some, but it is necessary for administrative purposes.

Q: **What is a:**

Buckaroo or Buckarette: Shooter 12 to 13 years of age on first day of main match.

Young Gun: Shooter 14 to 16 years of age on first day of main match.

Conventioneer: Anyone who wants to participate in all aspects of the match **except** the main match shooting. A conventioneer entry includes a shooters book, badge, one round of side matches, and all meals. It does not include door prize or special prize drawings.

Q: **What goes on the extra lunches and/or dinners line?**

A: This is for meals not covered in an entry. Example: Your friend comes to watch the match and join you for a meal. This covers his/her meal cost. There will be a few meals available for purchase at the match.

Q: **Is this a SASS sanctioned match?**

A: Yes it is and as such all shooters must be current SASS members and SASS rules apply.

B: Categories with only 1 or 2 entries may be combined with a similar category. Entrant will be notified of change 30 days prior to match.

Q: **Do you have any tips on driving through Canada, buying ammo, guns, places to stay, etc.?**

Q: **Do you have gun carts to rent or loan?**

A: Yes we have a limited number of gun carts to *loan*. Contact Marshal Stone (see above) to reserve one.

Q: **Does the range have RV camping?**

A: No. There are several RV campgrounds nearby. The closest is Fox Run Lodge & RV Campground just two miles away. 907-745-6120

Q: **Can I bring my pet to the match?**

A: They are not allowed at the range. If you bring your pets, be prepared to keep them at your RV or vehicle.
